### Hi Jeffersonians:

This is a big election year for State and County offices, with many candidates seeking election or re-election for various positions. For the first time, the State of Jefferson (SOJ) is hosting a candidate's forum, on Tuesday April 10<sup>th</sup> at the American Legion Hall, 4561 Greenstone Road, in Placerville.

The El Dorado County (EDC) SOJ Committee invites you to join us for our pre-meeting social hour from 5:30 – 6:30 PM. This month we will be serving hot dogs, chips, beverages and desserts and the meeting and forum will begin at the normal time, 6:30 to 8 PM.

On April 10<sup>th</sup>, the SOJ committee is excited to have candidate for State Attorney General, Judge Steven Bailey, as one of the forum participants. Judge Bailey has been a long time resident of El Dorado County, supporter of the SOJ, and has a real good shot at defeating the corrupt Attorney General we now have, Xavier Becerra. Also participating, will be the candidates for El Dorado County Supervisor, District 4 and those seeking the seat of Treasurer-Tax Collector.

Because of the number of offices and candidates, Jefferson will host two forums. We will have a second forum during our next monthly meeting, Tuesday May 8<sup>th</sup>, same time and location. We are hopeful to get Mark Meuser who is running for Secretary of State against the corrupt Alex Padilla. Announcements about the offices and candidates for the May meeting, will be announced later. Special district elections; school, fire, water, etc., will only be on the November ballot.

The SOJ Committee, cannot stress enough the importance of voting in the June 5<sup>th</sup> primary and being an informed voter, by using every opportunity to get to know the candidates and the issues. Your vote on June 5<sup>th</sup>, will determine who will be on the final ballot in the general election, on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

Voter registration forms will also be available at both the April 10<sup>th</sup> and May 8<sup>th</sup> meetings. Remember, if you or someone you know will turn the age of 18 before these election dates, they can register now.

### A Great Turnout at the Board of Supervisors Meeting Today

Thank you Jeffersonians that were able to attend this morning's supervisor meeting. The parking lot was completely filled and people were parking on the street. The boardroom was packed with standing room only, and the overflow from the boardroom had the lobby equally packed.

Sheriff D'Agostini gave a great talk about the safety issues that come with Sanctuary Jurisdiction. Congressman Tom McClintock's Staffer delivered a letter from the Congressman supporting the EDC citizens that do not want to be a Sanctuary Jurisdiction. We had many Veterans and SOJ Patriots that spoke with a great deal of passion denouncing California's Unconstitutional Sanctuary Law.

The Board was given a Resolution to act on. This Resolution would declare that EDC will not establish a Sanctuary Jurisdiction, and will comply with Federal Immigration Law. We will get a copy of this Resolution and a copy of Congressman McClintock letter sent to those of you that are on the EDC minuteman list. If you are not on this list, you can sign up at our next monthly meeting.

We urge all in SOJ El Dorado County, to call into the new "State of Jefferson Hour" Radio show, every Sunday, from 10 to 11 am, on KAHJ Radio, 950 AM or 104.5 FM, featuring special guests and often, co-hosts from your own SOJ committee. On Sunday April 8<sup>th</sup>, SOJ Placer County's, Paul Gallo, will kick off a series of shows starting with the State of Jefferson: "How Did We start and How Did We Get Here." Follow up shows will focus on what the new State might look like, to include, a look at a "True Representative State Government," "Local, County Controlled Education System," "Taxes, Finance and Economic Viability in the new State."

Guests have been invited from throughout the State of Jefferson and are excited about taking calls from our greater listening audience. Paul and his guests want to hear your questions and suggestions, about what you would like to see happen in the State of Jefferson.
