Important County News from Our Local High School Trustee Todd White

Education in our County, State and Nation, is one of the most important issues we have. Our next guest speaker, El Dorado Union High School District Trustee Todd White, will be giving a historical perception of America's Public Education System. In addition to this, Todd will share important information about the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors (BOS). Please join us next Tuesday, September 11 at the American Legion Hall, 4561 Greenstone Road, in Placerville.

Mr. White will brief the audience about the BOS recent decision to amend our County Charter. A County Charter is the County's Constitution. The El Dorado County Charter was ratified by the voters in 1994, and is 1 of only 14 County Charters in the State. Also, the Board has voted to have a Measure on the November ballot, to extend their term limits. They currently have 2, four year terms and want them extended to 3, four year terms. Todd White will also talk about another amendment the BOS will be placing on the 2020 ballot.

Prior to introducing Todd White, we will have an update on the court case and announce dates of upcoming events. The doors open at 5:30 PM, for social hour and to enjoy hot dogs, chips, cookies and beverages. We would like to also use this time, for new people and others to find out more about Jefferson, by talking to one of the SOJ Committee members. Just make a request at the welcome table, when you first arrive at the meeting. The meeting will begin at 6:30 PM, and a few minutes will be taken to remember those who died on that tragic day of September 11, 2001. *Lest we never forget.*

This can be coordinated with the Yes on 6 Gas Tax and Vehicle Fee Repeal. The signs are bright yellow and coordinate well with Jefferson signs and gear and don't forget those American Flags. The Republican Central Committee (RCC) has just opened their headquarters and is one of the distribution points for Yes on 6 signs, stickers and information. Terry Gherardi is the manager of the Republican Election Campaign Headquarters, located at 3161 Cameron Park Drive, Suite 111, across the road from the Cameron Park Airport. Terry is urging all to pick up some signs and assist in getting out the vote over the next 60 days. The RCC along with all Jeffersonians have received permission to have signs for Yes on 6 and Get out the Vote Rally, at the Mobile Gas Station right off Highway 50 in Cameron Park.
