Hearing Set For Citizens for Fair Representation vs State of California

August 11, 2017

Update for recent press release: *Citizen's for Fair Representation's Court Case Moves Forward.*

Just hours after Judge K. Mueller's request for the Chief Magistrate to appoint a 3-judge panel in the case; Citizens for Fair Representation vs Secretary of State Alex Padilla, on August 3, the State's Attorney's filed an ex parte (emergency) motion, to “reconsider” the order to appoint a three judge panel.

Soon after May 8th, when CFR filed the lawsuit against the State, for lack of representation and dilution of vote, the State filed a motion for dismissal. Judge Mueller than set a hearing date of August 25th, to hear arguments.

Today, it was learned that Judge Mueller has now issued a new minute order for August 25th, at 10 am in Courtroom 3 to hear the State's Attorney's motion to “reconsider” the order to appoint a three judge panel.

Another hearing is set for September 8th, also at 10 am in Courtroom 3, for the hearing on Citizens for Fair Representation's motion to amend their complaint to include their additional plaintiffs.
